OVERVIEW


All patrons have at-home or library access. Some libraries may have our logo on their home page and some provide access in a list of vendors. Either way, entering your library card number and your state puts you in Journey's archives.

Welcome To The Time Vault!

Think of the Time Vault as a museum instead of as a database.

- In the **Articles In Timeline** tab, select an Era to view years, then click a year to view the headlines from the year in chronological sequence.
- In the **Articles Grouped In Themes** tab, select an Era, pick a Theme, and wander through the past as it was captured in daily newspapers, magazines and documents.
- Or, choose the **Search for Articles/Documents** tab to find specific events -- the auto fill option will make suggestions as you type.

Need help getting started? Try this search in **Articles Grouped In Themes**:
Choose the *Depression Era* in the drop-down menu, and scroll down to *Hindenburg*. Expand the list of headlines to find articles and photographs about the Hindenburg disaster.
